- Ensure the health and safety of the children participating in the camp program

- Monitor and provide care for the children participating in the camp program
- Provide and actively participate in all camp-related activities (i.e. nature hikes, games, crafts)
- Implement required tasks, such as set up and clean-up and other day-to-day camp operations as directed by the Lead Camp Counselor, and Coordinator.
- Act as a positive role model and leader at all times
- Encourage camp participants to follow proper hygiene and cleanliness
- Build positive relationships with camp staff, participants, and parents and/or caregivers
- To follow all policies and procedures as required.
- Other duties as assigned.

- At least 2 years background in natural history, environmental studies, tourism, recreation/leisure and /or education acquired via university, college or equivalent work experience.
